Onsite students attend in the classroom while online students join remotely through live video conferencing. Both groups receive real-time instruction, interaction, and academic guidance.	Students who can attend scheduled classes and want live discussion with professors and classmates.
Modular Program	A separate flexible learning track using prepared modules, readings, assignments, ministry-related activities, and guided academic requirements. This is not the same as the live onsite/online class schedule.	Pastors, church workers, missionaries, working students, and students who cannot regularly attend live classes.
